COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing Sites

I am happy to announce that the COVID-19 vaccine will now be available at two sites within Council District 45.

Vaccine offered: Johnson & Johnson (18+)

Flatbush YMCA

Now through Sunday, May 9th from 9 AM to 6 PM

Vaccine offered: Pfizer (16+)

New Yorkers, ages 16 and older, are eligible to be vaccinated. If you live outside of New York State but work or study within the state, you are also eligible to receive the vaccine. **No appointment is required.**

Note: Eligible 16 and 17-year-olds may receive Pfizer vaccine **only**. Sites administering Moderna and Johnson & Johnson will not administer those vaccines to 16- and 17-year-olds. The [FDA Fact Sheet on the Johnson & Johnson/Janssen](#) (PDF) vaccine has been updated to note the rare blood clot cases.

Alternatively, please complete the [Interest Form for In-Home Vaccinations](#) for fully homebound and eligible New York City residents who have not already been vaccinated and do not already have access to a vaccination program.

I encourage you to do your research on the three vaccines and explore all of the available options within your neighborhood.

NOTE: The [FDA Fact Sheet on the Johnson & Johnson/Janssen](#) (PDF) vaccine has been updated to note the rare blood clot cases. The [CDC and FDA](#) have made the Johnson & Johnson/Janssen vaccine available for use again, following an expert panel's recommendation. According to the Fact Sheet, if you have received the Johnson & Johnson/Janssen vaccine in the past three weeks and are having any of the following symptoms, contact your health care provider:

- Severe headache
- Chest or abdominal pain
- Leg pain or swelling
- Shortness of breath
- Easy bruising or tiny blood spots under the skin at the site of injection
